It is time to say goodbye as the HubIT Project reaches its end this February after 42 months. During this time, the HubIT consortium has worked intensively to build a hub that has activated and improved constructive and co-creative interactions between the Social Science & Humanities (SSH) and Information & Communication Technologies (ICT), towards developing and implementing a shared vision of inclusive ICT research and innovation.

We've developed the **HubIT Metropolis**: A three-station city where the **community** (composed of almost 100 users) interacts and has access to a multitude of resources to make ICT innovation & research closer to society. Check on this newsletter the resources we've developed.

We've organized more than **30 events**, from Policy Workshops to Hackathons, from National Workshops to our Annual Conferences, where we brought together the ICT and SSH communities to make Responsible Research and Innovation (RRI) a reality. Not even the pandemic stopped us: we turned to virtual. Just check the timeline of the events on the right.

We've proposed **policy recommendations and best practices** by establishing **success indicators** for community building and engagement that were tested on the HubIT project, measuring the impacts that the project generated and providing evidence base for exploitation and sustainability of the project.

But this is not the end of the journey. Begin with us an expedition to bridge the ICT and SSH communities by becoming a **HubIT Ambassador**

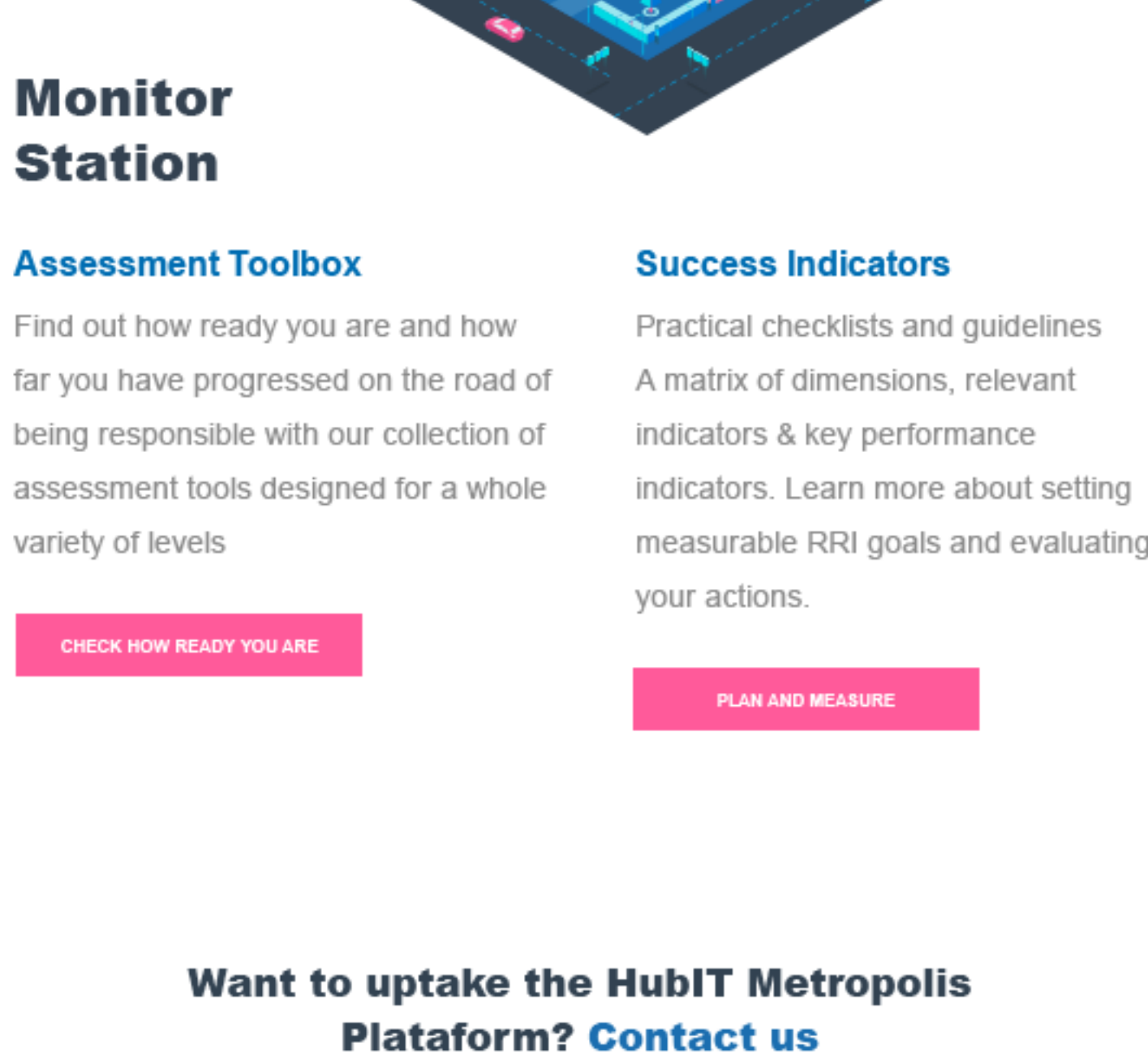
